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Adding Fractions

- 1) $\frac{3}{5} + \frac{1}{10} = \frac{6}{10} + \frac{1}{10} = \frac{7}{10}$
- 2) $\frac{1}{2} + \frac{2}{4} = \frac{2}{4} + \frac{2}{4} = \frac{4}{4} = 1$
- 3) $\frac{2}{10} + \frac{2}{3} = \frac{6}{30} + \frac{20}{30} = \frac{26}{30} = \frac{13}{15}$
- 4) $\frac{4}{5} + \frac{3}{10} = \frac{8}{10} + \frac{3}{10} = \frac{11}{10} = 1 \frac{1}{10}$
- 5) $\frac{1}{2} + \frac{6}{10} = \frac{5}{10} + \frac{6}{10} = \frac{11}{10} = 1 \frac{1}{10}$
- 6) $\frac{9}{10} + \frac{2}{3} = \frac{27}{30} + \frac{20}{30} = \frac{47}{30} = 1 \frac{17}{30}$
- 7) $\frac{4}{5} + \frac{1}{2} = \frac{8}{10} + \frac{5}{10} = \frac{13}{10} = 1 \frac{3}{10}$
- 8) $\frac{1}{3} + \frac{1}{2} = \frac{2}{6} + \frac{3}{6} = \frac{5}{6}$
- 9) $\frac{9}{10} + \frac{2}{3} = \frac{27}{30} + \frac{20}{30} = \frac{47}{30} = 1 \frac{17}{30}$
