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Multiplying Fractions

- 1) $\frac{4}{10} \times \frac{1}{4} = \frac{4 \times 1}{10 \times 4} = \frac{4}{40} = \frac{1}{10}$
- 2) $\frac{2}{5} \times \frac{2}{3} = \frac{2 \times 2}{5 \times 3} = \frac{4}{15}$
- 3) $\frac{5}{10} \times \frac{2}{3} = \frac{5 \times 2}{10 \times 3} = \frac{10}{30} = \frac{1}{3}$
- 4) $\frac{3}{5} \times \frac{1}{2} = \frac{3 \times 1}{5 \times 2} = \frac{3}{10}$
- 5) $\frac{1}{4} \times \frac{6}{10} = \frac{1 \times 6}{4 \times 10} = \frac{6}{40} = \frac{3}{20}$
- 6) $\frac{3}{4} \times \frac{4}{5} = \frac{3 \times 4}{4 \times 5} = \frac{12}{20} = \frac{3}{5}$
- 7) $\frac{1}{4} \times \frac{1}{3} = \frac{1 \times 1}{4 \times 3} = \frac{1}{12}$
- 8) $\frac{8}{10} \times \frac{2}{4} = \frac{8 \times 2}{10 \times 4} = \frac{16}{40} = \frac{2}{5}$
- 9) $\frac{2}{5} \times \frac{8}{10} = \frac{2 \times 8}{5 \times 10} = \frac{16}{50} = \frac{8}{25}$
- 10) $\frac{2}{5} \times \frac{2}{4} = \frac{2 \times 2}{5 \times 4} = \frac{4}{20} = \frac{1}{5}$
- 11) $\frac{1}{2} \times \frac{2}{4} = \frac{1 \times 2}{2 \times 4} = \frac{2}{8} = \frac{1}{4}$
- 12) $\frac{2}{3} \times \frac{1}{5} = \frac{2 \times 1}{3 \times 5} = \frac{2}{15}$
- 13) $\frac{2}{4} \times \frac{7}{10} = \frac{2 \times 7}{4 \times 10} = \frac{14}{40} = \frac{7}{20}$
- 14) $\frac{1}{4} \times \frac{3}{5} = \frac{1 \times 3}{4 \times 5} = \frac{3}{20}$
- 15) $\frac{1}{5} \times \frac{2}{10} = \frac{1 \times 2}{5 \times 10} = \frac{2}{50} = \frac{1}{25}$
